# **Annual Report for the Year 2019-2020**

Annual report of the activities of the Society for the year 2019-20 is presented below:

### **Annual General Meeting**

The 63<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Body Meeting of the Society was held on 6<sup>th</sup> March 2019 at the Centre of Advanced Study in Geology, University of Lucknow, Lucknow. Prof. M. P. Singh presided over the meeting. 50 fellows attended the meeting.

### **Council Meetings**

The Executive Council of the Society met on 5 occasions during the preceding year for transacting the routine business of the Society.

- 1. **37**th **M.R. Sahni Lecture** was delivered on 6th March 2019 by Prof. Sunil Bajpai, Department of Earth Sciences, IIT, Roorkee on "Tertiary Vertebrate Faunas of India: Recent advances in evolutionary and biogeographic scenarios" in the Geology Department, University of Lucknow, Lucknow'
- 2. **21st Prof. S. N. Singh Memorial Lecture** entitled, 'Palaeoseismic and Active fault mapping in Central and NW Himalaya' was delivered by Prof. Javed N. Malik, Department of Earth Sciences, IIT, Kanpur on 19th September, 2019.

#### Awards & Medals:

**Prof. S. K. Singh Memorial Gold Medal for 2018**, for the best research paper published in the volume 63 (2018) of the Journal of the Palaeontological Society of India which was conferred on Dr. S. Nawaz Ali, Scientist of BSIP, Lucknow on 6<sup>th</sup> March, 2019.

Mani Shanker Shukla Gold Medal for outstanding contributions by a young researcher in the field of Micropalaeontology for the year 2018 was conferred upon Dr. Santosh K. Pandey, Scientist of BSIP, Lucknow on 6th March, 2019.

M.R. Sahni Memorial Gold Medal was awarded to Miss Shruti Saxena for securing highest percentage of marks in Palaeontology at 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Semester (Combined) examinations of 2019 of Lucknow University.

**Prof. S.N. Bhalla Gold Medal (2019)** for outstanding contributions in the field of micropalaeontology was awarded to Prof. Devesh Sinha of Delhi University on 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 during the 27<sup>th</sup> ICMS at B.H.U., Varanasi.

8<sup>th</sup> Prof. R. C. Misra Life Time Achievement Award was conferred upon Dr. V. P. Dimri, FNA, former Director, NGRI on 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 during a meeting of FIGA at Hyderabad.

Students and well wishers of Dr. Rajiv Nigam of the National Institute of Oceanography (Goa) have requested the P.S.I. to institute a medal in honour of Dr. Nigam as '**Dr. Rajiv Nigam Medal**' for outstanding work in palaeontology (preferably micropalaeontology) for scientists working in India to be awarded once in two years. The Council agreed to the proposal. An amount of Rs. 2 lakhs has been deposited by them with the P.S.I. to finance the medal.

# **International Fossil Day:**

The Society celebrated **International Fossil Day** on 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 in collaboration with the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeosciences (BSIP) at Lucknow. A large number of school and college students participated in the event. Six lectures on various popular geoscientific topics were delivered by the scientists of BSIP. Dr. V.P. Mishra, Dr. Mukund Sharma, Dr. Amit K. Ghosh, Dr. Anupam Sharma and Dr. Purnima Srivastava interacted with students. The school children also visited the BSIP labs, museum and analytical facilities.

Under the Student Chapter of the Palaeontological Society of India, the Earth Science Centres at the Jammu University (Jammu), Madras University (Chennai) and Shri Guru Ram Rai P.G. College, Dehradun organised International Fossil day on 16<sup>th</sup> October, 2019 by involving the students of schools and colleges. The students interacted with the scientists and were given lectures on various interesting topics. They also visited the museums. The effort was well appreciated by the students.

### Workshop

A workshop on **Applied Biostratigraphy in Mineral and Hydrocarbon Exploration** was organised by the Society from **20-22 November, 2019** in Lucknow in association with CAS in Geology, University of Lucknow and B.S.I.P., Lucknow. About one hundred delegates, researchers, scientists and resource persons participated in the workshop. Successful organisation of the workshop by Dr. Sudhir Shukla, Vice President of the Society & Organising Secretary of the workshop is well appreciated and commended by the participants.
